#### 2021 LANDSCAPE



According to the International Data Corporation (IDC), "[the] total worldwide spending on cloud services, the hardware and software components underpinning cloud services, and the professional and managed services opportunities around cloud services will surpass \$1.0 trillion in 2024 while sustaining a double-digit compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 15.7%."

Data also suggests that Fortune 1000 companies make up over \$14.2 trillion in revenue, making up two-thirds of the U.S. economy, according to the latest numbers. Digital transformation powered by cloud computing is estimated to be around \$700 billion and 80% of B2B sales interactions between suppliers and buyers will occur in digital channels by 2025, according to Gartner.


Today, only 3% of corporate procurement dollars and 5% of federal contracts are going to women-owned firms. This situation is compounded by investors reducing their investment in women-led tech companies taking it to less than 2%. It is no wonder that only 2% of women-owned businesses ever make it to \$1 million in revenue, which is 3.5 times less than their male counterparts.

As an economic development organization, we at Women in Cloud are on a global mission to take action with global leaders, corporations, and policymakers to help women technology entrepreneurs create \$1 billion in economic access and opportunity by 2030.

#### 2021 A YEAR OF IMPACT

- We have seen 500% Expansion and Growth of our community with 60% engagement rate on a month to month basis across all channels
- In partnership with Insight Success magazine, 10 Women in Cloud entrepreneurs have been recognized as Top 10 Most Successful Entrepreneurs in the Industry
- Women in Cloud has launched the first digital marketplace showcasing over 50 cloud solutions developed by female founders in the tech industry catering to Fortune brands and enterprise companies.
- To create greater access, Women In Cloud has expanded our industry-recognized stages to provide access for over 1200 women to represent their voice, become advisors, share their learnings and create access for others this year.
- In partnership with M12, we've also launched the #empowHERaccess digital advocacy campaign to spotlight more than a hundred champions, including thought leaders, technology entrepreneurs, role models, advisors, mentors and other allies of women in tech. The digital spotlight campaign reached more than 1.4M impressions and 144K people across social media channels.
- Women in Cloud rolled out the Fortune 100 Initiative, a turn-key equity advancing solution for Fortune brands to come together and collectively solve gender-equity challenges through representation, recruitment, and relationship building.
- To address COVID crisis in India, #empowerHERfamily, a crosssector economic relief initiative has been launched to empower
   1M women in India to have an effective future by curating actionable digital solutions to provide economic relief.
- Finally, over 1500+ azure training and certification scholarships were made available to skill for women in-demand cloud jobs.




